Dr Tony Young trained as a secondary maths-science teacher in NSW and spent four years teaching in that state. He then transferred to Queensland and spent a year each at Richmond and Stanthorpe before entering the Royal Australian Navy as a Lieutenant in 1969. After 15 years spent teaching mostly electronics and having trained as a Staff Officer, he left the navy in 1975 as a Lieutenant-Commander and then taught for a further 11 years in Queensland. During all this time, he studied externally and completed a BA (UNE), Litt.B. (UNE), Msc (UQld) and his doctorate (UQld) in 1996. In addition, he published his own book on fungi (Common Australian Fungi) and as a result of his work with ABRIS, his PhD thesis work on the Hygrosporaceae was published as a volume in their Fungi of Australia series. Tony has also acted as a director of Binna Burra and published a CD for the Lodge containing information on the Lamington NP its walks, flora and fauna as well as additional information on the history of Binna Burra Lodge. He has published 37 research papers on Australian fungi and a further 14 papers with joint authorship.
